A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Expressing support for the people of the Red Shirt community on the Pine Ridge Reservation.

WHEREAS, the Red Shirt Table area of the Pine Ridge Reservation has a long, rich, and varied history encompassing both Native and non-Native economic and cultural pursuits and practices; and

WHEREAS, the people of the Red Shirt community have deep roots and strong ties to the land and respect for the traditions and aspirations of their neighbors; and

WHEREAS, like their fellow South Dakotans, the people of the Red Shirt community continue to strive for and promote opportunities for economic development and financial well-being and to provide satisfying and fulfilling lives for themselves, their families, and the members of their community:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Eighty-Ninth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that the South Dakota Legislature respects and supports the efforts of the people of the Red Shirt community on the Pine Ridge Reservation to preserve and protect their economic livelihoods and their cultural, historical, and social heritage and traditions.
